- 2. Should women use violence to protect themselves? Regardless of your answer, under what circumstances might the opposite be true?
- 3. Janet Chandler takes her very young daughter to a shooting range so that she'll respect firearms. Given the Canadian view of guns, was this a reasonable thing to do?
- 4. Why are Kali and Veronica such good friends? What does each of them supply to the relationship?
- 5. How much does Veronica's medical condition really affect her? Is she as different as she thinks she is from a "normal" woman?
- 6. One of the main themes in *The Stable Vices Affair* is the nature of infidelity. How would you handle infidelity in real life, especially if it had extenuating circumstances?
